- All poems and songs must be original and unpublished.
- 2 copies of each poem/lyrics must be submitted for the entry to be valid.
- Parents must sign entry forms if students are under 16 years old.
- Bush poetry is to be rhyming bush verse with an Australian theme. Each poem must have good rhyme and a regular metre.
- Works must be printed or typed on one side only of A4 plain paper with no artwork or decoration.

- Poems & songs will not be returned, and only finalists will be notified.
- Finalists will be invited to read their own poem and/or perform their song (or allow it to be read or performed) at A Feast of Poetry Day, 4th November 2012.
- Songs will be judged mainly on strength of the song lyric.
- The judges' decision is final.
- Selection of poems / lyrics for publication is at the discretion of the committee. The poems may be published in the annual anthology, selected writers' magazines and local papers.
